South Yorkshire Vernacular: review day of Buildings of Hallamshire and the Dark Peak

Saturday 14 September 2019 – From 9am

at the Showroom Cinema, Sheffield, opposite the railway station

Guided architectural tour of Sheffield City centre led by David Hornsby

Our recording in the Sheffield area was a great success, supported by enthusiastic recording teams ably led by team leaders who are keen to share their buildings (pictured below) with you. Two barns: one post-and-truss with a single-aisle, the other cruck-framed with remnants of timber-framed end walls. Two houses: similar with a part-medieval fifteenth century post-and-truss house that revealed more of itself when we recorded it, and a superb two-cell cruck-framed house – the crucks with a mid-sixteenth century dendro-date, stone-clad in 1671 with decorative label stops (drip-mould terminations). Then two mid-to-late seventeenth century houses, both with two-cell plans, continuous outshuts, and end-lobby entries; one two-storeys the other three-storeys with firehood and spiral staircases. Finally a seventeenth century stone 'wing', a remnant of a large timber-framed mansion (demolished in the 1850s) which contains two oak panelled rooms of the finest quality with outstanding fireplaces and which has been the subject of much documentary research by the recording team; this will feature in next year's annual day school rather than this one. Come and see these on the big cinema screen in comfortable seats at a great venue; it will be worth the early start!

Tea, coffee and biscuits on arrival from 9am to 9.15am. We have arranged a hot buffet-style lunch at the Showroom Cinema, followed by a walkabout departing at 2pm, limited to the first 25 people who book.


