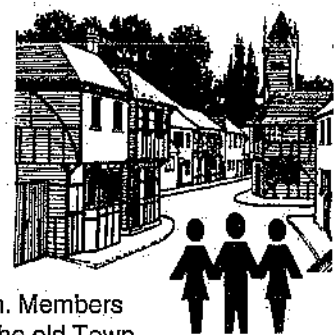
On Sunday 19 June Sue Wrathmell will lead a walk round Skipton and Carleton-in-Craven. Members should meet at 10.30am in Sheep Street at the old Town Hall (now the Tourist Information Centre), Skipton.

Lunch will be between 12 and 2 pm and can be taken in Skipton or the pub in Carleton (or of course members can bring their own).

The afternoon walk round Carleton, lasting about 2 hours, will start at 2 pm from St Mary's Church. The history of the village, from the deserted medieval village to the 1861 mill, will be covered with particular reference to the 17th century farms and barns.

Sue describes herself as a 'building historian'. Having taken a first degree in Archaeology she switched to a Vernacular Architecture course at Manchester and is now working on the listed building re-survey for English Heritage.
