The Treasurer would remind members that subscriptions became due on 1 January. As explained in the last Newsheet, the annual fee was increased at last year's AGM to £5 per person.

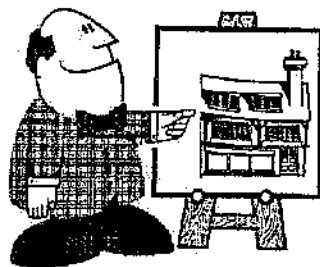
Access to reports
